NIGHT ROAD CLOSURES IN SIDCUP TOWN CENTRE

The Sidcup Town Area Renewal (STAR) improvement scheme has been progressing well since September 2016. The works are nearing completion now with one of the final stages, resurfacing the road, due to take place next week.

To carry out this vital work it will be necessary to close the Main Road/Elm Road/ Station Rd /High St junction in all directions from 7pm–2am for four nights from Monday 27 – 30 March.

All roads, except for the High Street eastbound, will be open as normal during the day. This section of road will be closed at the Main Road/Station Road junction to Hatherley Road from Tuesday 28 March for work outside McDonalds. The High Street will be open westbound during the day as usual.

Diversion routes suitable for all vehicle types will be sign posted during these periods and bus services will operate as close to the normal route as possible. Residents and businesses close to the affected area will be receiving information on the works from today.

The STAR scheme has already significantly improved pedestrian access and the street environment in the High Street and around the station. For more information on the improvements visit www.bexley.gov.uk/STAR.
