COUNCIL INVITES VIEWS ON ITS DRAFT GROWTH STRATEGY

An eight-week public consultation has been launched on Bexley's draft Growth Strategy. The Council is hoping as many people as possible will take the opportunity to find about its plans for growth and give their views.

"This is our manifesto for growth," says Gill Steward, the Council's Chief Executive. "Increasing demand for housing and land is already having an impact on the borough. The Growth Strategy will put us in control, so we can ensure that the change that happens benefits the borough and our residents."

Consultation on the strategy will run from 18 May to 14 July.

"As well as giving us their comments, this is a chance for everyone interested in how the borough will grow in the future to read about our plans and learn about the opportunities we aim to create," said Jane Richardson, Assistant Chief Executive for Regeneration and Growth. "It's also a chance to ask questions about the strategy and debate the issues involved."
