**Abbey Wood Station Public Realm Improvements – Gayton Road/Florence Road  
/Wilton Road resurfacing work Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2019 – Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

Next week we will be carrying out road resurfacing work in Gayton Road, Florence Road and Wilton Road. The programme of work is as follows below.

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May/Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May – We will be working in Gayton Road and Florence Road, much of our works will be in the area we already have closed off, however we will be extending the resurfacing into Florence Road just past the junction with Fendyke Road. These works will be carried out in daytime working hours between 07:30 and 17:00. During this time the junction at Fendyke Road/Florence Road will be closed. Access/egress to Florence Road and Gayton Road Car Park will be from Abbey Road with traffic marshals controlling access.

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May/Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May – We will be resurfacing Wilton Road. This work will be carried out over two nights between the hours of 19:00 and 02:00 to minimise disruption. So far as is practical, noisy operations such as removing the existing road surface, will be ended around 23:00 hours and other works no later than 02:00 hours. The road will reopen a couple of hours later depending on curing time and weather conditions.

To enable the resurfacing work to take place, all car parking will be suspended in Wilton Road from 18:00 on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May until 08:00 on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

During the night time working hours, Wilton Road will be closed to vehicles from the junction with Abbey Road, however pedestrian access to local facilities such as the train station and local businesses will be maintained as well as access to local residences.

All this work is weather sensitive and therefore the programme is subject to change if we have bad weather.

The work will be carried out by the Council's contractor for highway works, F M Conway who can be contacted on **01732 600700**.

We will do everything we can to minimise any disruption. London Borough of Bexley apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may result during the implementation of the scheme.
